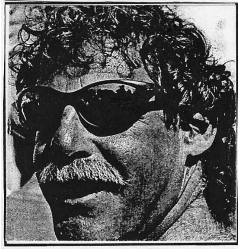

* Contest Update: the 2010 Memorial Day Contest will be held at the Lane. Waylon is carefully managing our budget. More contest updates will be on the way...

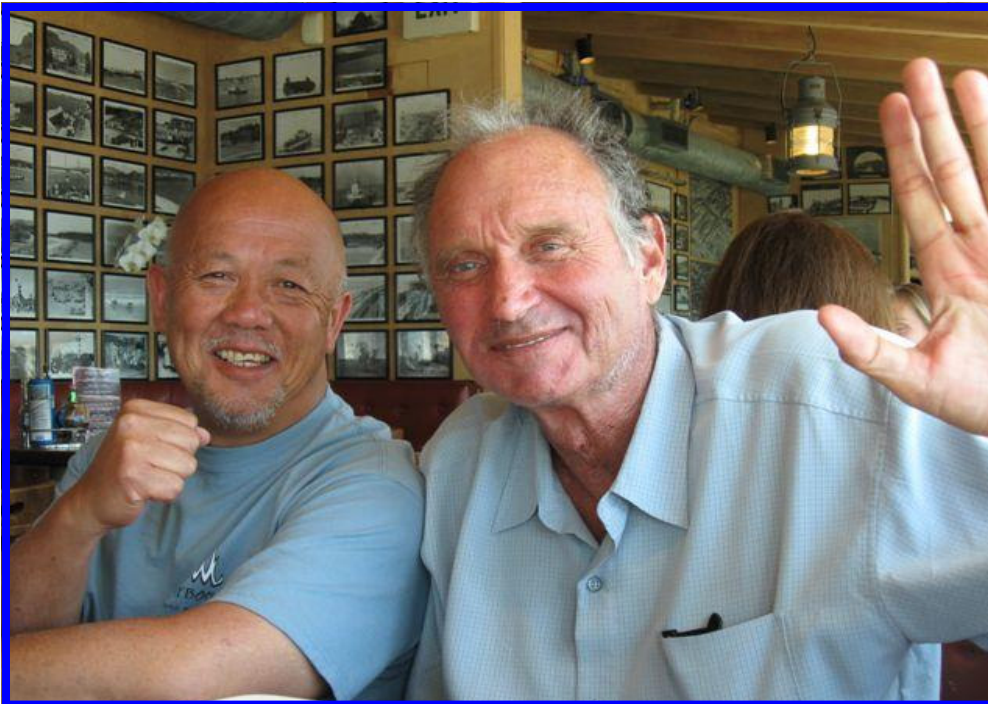

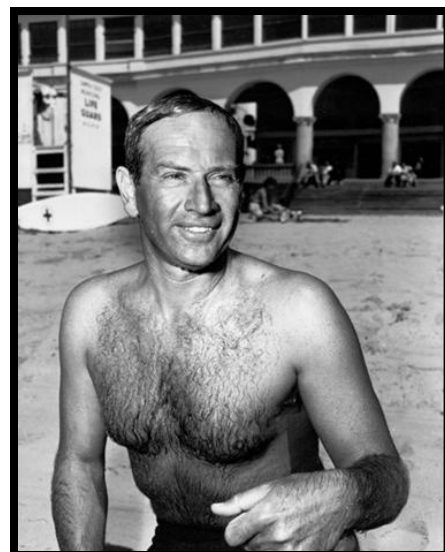
March Dino's Den:
